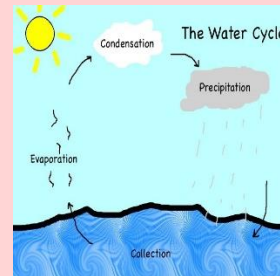


Science (Chemistry): States of Matter
