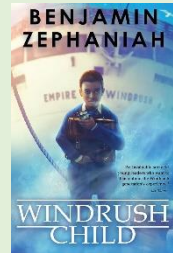

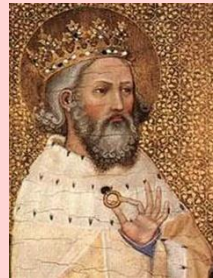


Science: Animals Including Humans
