RSHE – Emotional Well-Being

Unit 2, Modules 1-3 Personal Relationships helps children to develop a more complex appreciation of different family structures, develop healthy relationships with family and friends, learning some strategies to use when relationships become difficult. Teaching also covers how to recognise discrimination and bullying, both physical and emotional.

English: Other Cultures/Traditional Tales

Measurement: Length and Perimeter

Number: Fractions (Unit A)

Each maths session will start with a mental maths retrieval activity that encourages the children to recap and revise prior learning. One session each week will also develop their maths fluency and problem-solving strategies.



Science:

Animals Including Humans

We will learn about:

- Skeletons and muscles, some of their names, purposes and functions.



Geography: The UK

The children will extend their knowledge of compass points. In addition, they will develop an understanding of Grantham's place in the East Midlands and some of the features of our region. The names of local rivers will also be taught.



DT: Eating Seasonally

We will learn:

- About the seasonality of food
- The impact of climate on food growth
- To develop their peeling and cutting skills
- How to create and cook from a recipe

French (KS2): I am able...
