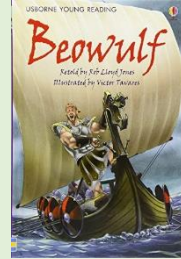

### Science:

#### Science (Physics): Sound

- Understanding sound production, propagation, and perception, including how vibrations create sound.
- How sound waves travel through a medium to reach the ear, the function of the ear in receiving sound waves, how pitch and volume are determined.
- The attenuation of sound with distance, and the variation in sound produced by different materials shaken in similar containers.

### History:

#### Anglo Saxons and Celts.

- Understand the historical placement of the Anglo Saxons and Scots (Celts), including their invasions of Britain.
- The formation of the seven Anglo Saxon kingdoms.
- The origins of modern place names, village design, craftsmanship, societal roles, religion, and the conversion of Britain to Christianity, exemplified by the establishment of the monastery on Lindisfarne.

### Art: Painting

- Pupils will learn various painting techniques using different brushes.
- Understand how to produce shape, texture, pattern.
- Understand the concepts of highlighting and shadowing.
- Study Georgia O'Keefe's techniques including reflections, and finally, create their own artwork showcasing the skills acquired during the term.
