Science: Physics - Forces

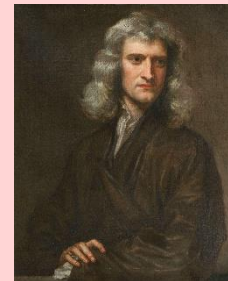
We will learn about:
