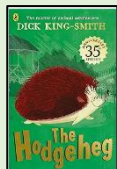
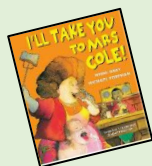
RSHE – This term the children will be focussing on the school values of: Love, respect, Honesty, Forgiveness, Patience and Generosity.

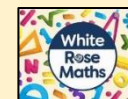
