RSHE – This term the children will be focussing


on the school values of: Love, respect, Honesty, Forgiveness, Patience and Generosity.

Maths:

Number: Place Value

Addition and Subtraction

Year 4

Each maths session will start with a mental maths retrieval activity that encourages the children to recap and revise prior learning. One session each week will also develop their maths fluency and problem-solving strategies. We will be looking at times tables ready for our times tables test in June.



Science: **Changing States**

We will have a chemistry focus as we look at the three states of matter, what happens when we heat or cool materials and the different stages of the Water Cycle.



History: Ancient Greece



We will be looking at what life was like in Ancient Greece, looking at the many Gods and Goddesses, the importance of Greek temples, know what the Greeks did for us and that the Olympic Games originated in Ancient Greece.



Art: Growing Artists

Our theme this term is Growing Artists. We will recognise how artists use shape in drawing, how to create tone in drawing by shading, how to create a 3D effect before creating a still life composition demonstrating from, tone and proportion.
