Adults should start to allow pupils more freedom and encourage them to begin to link and connect liturgical elements - using scripture as a foundation. Adults will still need to scaffold delivery of prayer and Celebrations of the Word until pupils are comfortable but should be aiming to increase independence and a deeper understanding of the liturgical process.
