Writing genres: Divers -Stories from other cultures – to plan, write and describe a 5-part story.

Letter (Informal) – to write main ideas organised into groups, use a letter structure and sequencing techniques

Instructions – to write sequenced steps, heading, opening statement and subheading

Geography: Egypt / UK comparisons

Children will know:

- The location, capital city and landmarks of Egypt
- How to identify the localities of Egypt on a map
- How to compare and find similarities with Egypt and the UK such as farming, nature and animals.
