Religious Education

- Listening and Sharing

RSHE – we will be looking at Religious Understanding, Personal Relationships and Life Online. Children will learn more about their relationship with God and how to maintain positive relationships in person. They will learn about being safe online and what to do if they see something inappropriate online.

English:

Reading text: The Butterfly Lion by Michael Morpurgo

Writing genres:

- Narrative story writing
- Non-Chronological Report
- Explanation text

Spellings:

- Children will be accessing Active Spelling 4 days a week.



Maths

Number: Fractions

Children will be comparing and ordering unit and non-unit fractions and exploring equivalent fractions.



Measurement: Mass and Capacity

Children will be using scales to measure mass in grams and kilograms. They will be using equivalent mass, capacity and volume to compare, add and subtract them

Science: Animals including humans

We will learn about:

- The purpose of a skeleton and some of the bones in the human body.
- What a muscle is and what they do.
- Creating a bionic hand.
- Invertebrates and animals without a backbone.



Geography: Ancient Egyptians

Children will learn about the significance of Gods, monuments and life after death to Egyptian people. This will help them to understand how the Ancient Egyptian came to be so wealthy.



Design & Technology: Cooking – Eating Seasonally

Children will explore seasonal foods for the UK through taste and appearance before planning creating and evaluating their own fruit tart using cutting and peeling skills.
