### English

**Whole Class Reading text:** A Variety of Texts from our Class Reading Spine.

### Science: Animals including Humans (Biology)

Children will...  
know how their body moves and that not all bodies move in the same way.  
know how to use their 5 senses when exploring the outdoor environment and how to record their findings  
know a variety of common minibeasts  
know some names of common birds and their characteristics  
know what camouflage is and that some animals use this to protect themselves

### History: Houses and Homes Now and Then

Children will know :

how the key features of houses have changed over time.  
Visit to Belton – Georgian property in local area.  
how kitchens have changed over time (comparing them with kitchens from today with kitchens 50yrs ago and 100yrs ago.)  
how lounges have changed over time. (comparing lounges from today with lounges 50yrs ago and 100yrs ago).

### Art and Design: 'Make your Mark'-Drawing Skills.

In Art we will learn how to:  
create different types of lines.  
explore line and mark making to draw water. draw with different media.  
develop an understanding of mark making  
apply an understanding of drawing materials and mark making to draw from observation.
