## English:

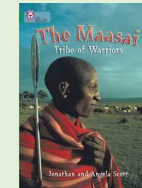
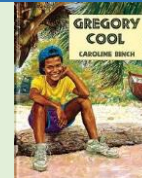

### Writing genres:

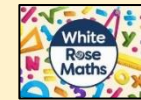

## Maths



### Measurement: Time

Children will learn how to tell the time to the minute, and understand the different durations of time (year, month, week, day, hour, minute, second)

### Geometry: Shape

Children will explore angles and begin to draw different shapes building on knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes..

### Statistics:

Children will interpret different graphs, pictograms and charts, and begin to collect and present data in different ways.

## Science: Plants

We will learn about:

- The different parts of a plant.
- What plants need to grow.
- How water moves through plants.
- Understand pollination and seed dispersal.



## Geography: Land Use

Children will learn about how land is used in their local area, and compare the ways in which land is used now, to how it was used in the past.



## DT: Drawing/Craft and Design – Mayan Masks

Children will be discovering how electrical circuits and electricity can be used within design to attract an audience. By the end of the unit, they will have designed, made and evaluated their own poster that uses a circuit.

**Music.** Children will learn about Latin music and they will compose and improvise a 4 bar rhythm, performing in front of the whole school with control, musicianship and rhythmic accuracy.



## French (KS2): Ice-cream



In this unit pupils will learn 10 flavours of ice-cream and the language needed to buy an ice-cream. By the end of the unit, they will be able to role play buying an ice-cream in French.

## Computing: Events and actions in programs

Children will use a selection of motion, sound and event blocks to create their own programs, thinking about linking events and actions.
