How to keep safe in the real world and how that links in with our Gospel Values.




Science: Plants






Children will learn about how land is used in their local area, and compare the ways in which land is used






Children will explore angles and begin to draw different shapes building on knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes..

Statistics:

Children will interpret different graphs, pictograms and charts, and begin to collect and present data in different ways.

DT: Drawing/Craft and Design – Mayan Masks

Children will be discovering how electrical circuits and electricity can be used within design to attract an audience. By the end of the unit, they will have designed, made and evaluated their own poster that uses a circuit.

Music. Children will learn about Latin music and they will compose and improvise a 4 bar rhythm, performing in front of the whole school with control, musicianship and rhythmic accuracy.
