Science: Light

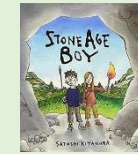
We will learn:



- We need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light
- Light is reflected from surfaces
- Light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes
- Shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object
- There are patterns in the way that the size of shadows change

- The Wild Way Home by Sophie Kirtley

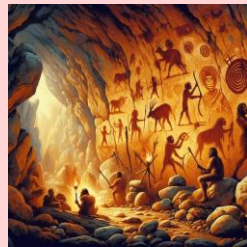
**Writing genres:**

In English children will be using the above texts to create extended pieces of writing linked to the focus genres listed. We will be focusing on using correct punctuation in sentences, spelling KS1 exception words accurately and introducing children to Year 3/4 words. In handwriting, we will be focusing on cursive joins for most letters.

Maths

- **Number:** Place Value
 - Represent numbers to 1,000
 - Estimate, order and partition numbers
- **Number:** Addition and Subtraction
 - Adding and subtracting 1s, 10s and 100s
 - Adding and subtracting 1s across 10 and 10s across 100
 - Adding and subtracting 2 and 3 digit number (no exchange)

History: Stone age to Iron age
