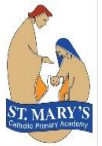

### Religious

#### Education:

#### RSHE – Emotional Wellbeing & Lifecycles

Children will understand the difference between feelings and actions, how to manage them to stay emotionally healthy. Children will explore the miraculous nature of human conception and birth. (Note that sexual intercourse is not discussed in this unit.) Children will gain an understanding of the complexities of grief and how to support themselves during death and gain understanding of the afterlife.

### French: Goldilocks and The Three Bears

Children will learn to listen more carefully to be able to understand a familiar fairy tale recounted in French using picture, word and phrase cards.

### Maths: Multiplication and Division/Length and Perimeter



Each maths session will start with a mental maths retrieval activity that encourages the children to recap and revise prior learning. We will be looking at times tables ready for our times tables test in June.

### History: Romans



We will be looking at the Roman Empire, what made the Roman Army so successful, why the Romans wanted to invade Britain, how they invaded and what they did for us as a nation.

### Art:

We will be looking at Roman jewellery and making some of our own. We will be watching our designs go from 2D to 3D.

### Music: Graphic Score

Pupils will begin to develop an understanding of harmony and how it can affect the mood of music.
