UtW The Natural World:

EAD Creating with Materials:

Making transport: Boats

- Explore what is meant by 'waterproof', 'floating' and 'sinking', then experiment and make predictions with various materials to carry out a series of tests.



Phonics

- Set 2 sounds: ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, oo, ar, or, air, ir, ou, oy
- blend words containing set 2 sounds
- build speed of reading words containing set 1 sounds
- Write longer sentences using phonic knowledge, write digraphs and trigraphs
