Children learn about simple beliefs and practices of other faiths, recognising similarities and differences with their own experiences.

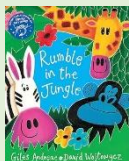


RSHE: Religious Understanding/ Living in the Wider World.

Children will know:

- that being made in His image means being called to be loved and to love other,
- no matter how small our offerings, they are valuable to God and He can use them for His glory.
- we have a duty of care for others and for the world we live in (charity work, recycling, etc.
- having a job can help us to look after each other and the world.
- money is valuable and is used as an exchange for needs and wants.

English



Whole Class Reading text: A Variety of Texts from our Class Reading Spine.

Writing genres: Poetry: Rumble in the Jungle.

- Writing simple sentences with a full stop, capital letters (inc places and personal pronoun) and spaces.
- Joining sentences with “and”, “but”, “because”, “so”.
- Using connectives (first, next, after that, finally)
- Embellish simple sentences using adjectives.

Maths



Number: Place Value to 100- Recognising, counting, ordering and comparing numbers up to 100.

Measurement: Money-Recognising coins and notes, making small amounts.

Time-Telling the time on an analogue clock to o clock and half last the hour.

Science: Animals inc Humans (Biology)

Children will...

- be able to identify, name and label body parts.
- explore what parts of our bodies we use for different activities.
- find out about the five senses, in particular the sense of sight.
- explore the sense of touch.
- explore the sense of smell.
- explore the sense of taste and sound.

Geography: The UK – the 4 countries and the seas.

Children will know :

- know the capital city of England and what makes England special.
- know the capital city of Scotland and what makes Scotland special.
- know the capital city of Wales and what makes Wales special.
- know the capital city of N. Ireland and what makes N. Ireland special.
- know the seas that surround the UK.

Design Technology: Structures.

Children will:

- know what a free standing structure is and evaluate existing structures,
- explore and evaluate how to make simple structures,
- design a simple structure,
- use tools and equipment accurately to start a structure,
- add finishing touches to a structure and evaluate a structure.

PE

- Wednesdays: - Outdoor PE – Athletics.
- Fridays: Indoor PE- Striking and Fielding.



Read, Write, Inc (Phonics)

All children in Year 1 will be taught phonics in small ability groups during the first lesson of each day. The reading scheme book they bring home matches the colour phonics group that they are learning in. Please read and discuss this book with your child daily. We hope that after reading their book 3 times they are ready to change it for a new one. If your child has completed the phonics scheme they will bring their choice of book home from the school, library. All children in Y1 will take the government Phonics Screening Test during the week beginning 8th June. Your child's results will be given in their end of year reports in July.
