Year 1

Religious Education: <u>To the Ends of the Earth.</u>  We will learn about the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and how the first Christians began to share the Good News of Jesus with others. Ten:Ten Resources RSHE: Keeping Safe.	English Whole Class Reading text: A Variety of Texts from our Class Reading Spine. Writing genres: Fairy Tales- The Elves and the Shoemaker & Hansel and Gretel (Talk for Writing)	Maths  Number: Multiplication and Division: 2's, 5's and 10's, arrays, grouping and sharing. Fractions: recognising and finding $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of an object, shape and quantity. Geometry: Position and Direction: describing turns and position, forwards, backwards, left & right, above and below, ordinal numbers.
WOW area: Year 1 children will be in the WOW area on a <u>Thursday</u> this half term. They will need to come to school dressed in their WOW clothes, suitable for the weather. The children will be split into two groups with one group going into the forest before playtime and one group after.	History: Houses and Homes Now and Then <u>Children will know :</u> how the key features of houses have changed over time. Visit to Belton – Georgian property in local area. how kitchens have changed over time (comparing them with kitchens from today with kitchens 50yrs ago and 100yrs ago.) how lounges have changed over time. (comparing lounges from today with lounges 50yrs ago and 100yrs ago). to know how these changes have impacted on our day to day lives.	Art and Design: 'Make your Mark'-Drawing Skills. <u>In Art we will learn how to:</u> create different types of lines. explore line and mark making to draw water. draw with different media. develop an understanding of mark making apply an understanding of drawing materials and mark making to draw from observation.
PE - Tuesdays: Indoor PE- Dance - Fridays: Outdoor PE – Net and Wall Skills. 	Key Dates	Music: "Imagination". Pupils will compose music as a class and then perform that music (basic rhythms – not necessarily with notation). 

Read, Write, Inc (Phonics)

All children in Year 1 will be taught phonics in small ability groups during the first lesson of each day. The reading scheme book they bring home matches the colour phonics group that they are learning in. Please read and discuss this book with your child daily. We hope that after reading their book 3 times they are ready to change it for a new one. Some children have started moving onto the Accelerated Reader scheme. All children will also be preparing for the governments Phonics Screening Check for all Year 1 pupils taking place in June 2026
