Science: Plants (Biology)

Children will...

- Identify parts of a plant
- Understand and identify different stages of the life cycle of a common plant
- Recognise what plants need to grow and how they can grow in different conditions

Geography: Egypt / UK comparisons

Children will know:

- The location, capital city and landmarks of Egypt
- How to identify the localities of Egypt on a map
- How to compare and find similarities with Egypt and the UK such as farming, nature and animals.
