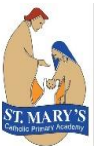

Religious Education

- Listening and Sharing
- Giving All



RSHE – we will be looking at Religious Understanding, Personal Relationships and Life Online. Children will learn more about their relationship with God and how to maintain positive relationships in person. They will learn about being safe online and what to do if they see something inappropriate online.

English:

Reading text: The Butterfly Lion by Michael Morpurgo

Writing genres:

- Narrative story writing
- Non-Chronological Report
- Explanation text

Spellings:

- Children will be accessing Active Spelling 4 days a week.



Maths

Measurement: Length and Perimeter



Children will learn how to convert between mm, cm and m, using them to calculate the length and perimeter of different objects.

Number: Fractions

Children will be comparing and ordering unit and non-unit fractions and exploring equivalent fractions.

Measurement: Mass and Capacity

Children will be using scales to measure mass in grams and kilograms. They will be using equivalent mass, capacity and volume to compare, add and subtract them

Science: WoW



Year 3 will be accessing the WoW area every Thursday morning to supplement the science curriculum. They will have hands on experience working with different plants and materials in the outdoors.

Geography: UK counties, cities and rivers

Children will learn about the counties which are local to Grantham and investigate their location in relation to where they live. Children will be using atlases to locate different cities within the UK and looking at the locations of different rivers in relation to these.



Design & Technology: Cooking – Eating Seasonally

Children will explore seasonal foods for the UK through taste and appearance before planning creating and evaluating their own fruit tart using cutting and peeling skills.
