



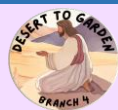

Religious Education:

Desert to Garden

We will learn that Jesus' parables and the Holy Week story show God's mercy and call Christians to change, journeying from the desert of sin toward the garden of forgiveness and hope.



RSHE – Created to Love Others

We will explore our relationship with others. Building on the understanding that we have been created out of love and for love, we will explore how we take this calling into our family, friendships and relationships, and learn strategies for developing healthy relationships and keeping safe both online and in our daily lives.

Science: States of Matter

We will be looking at what states of matter are and how certain materials change state. We will be exploring the different melting and freezing points through working scientifically and carrying out fair tests and observations. We will be learning about the process of evaporation and condensation.

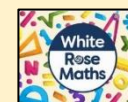

Whole Class Reading Text:

Maths: Length and Perimeter, Fractions and Decimals



We will be calculating length and perimeters of shapes. We will be counting beyond 1, partitioning mixed numbers, placing fractions on number lines, converting improper fractions to mixed numbers and vice versa and adding and subtraction fractions. We will be looking at tenths and hundredths as decimals. We will also be looking at times tables ready for our times tables test in June.

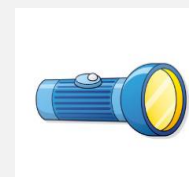
Geography: Settlements.

We are looking at what settlements are, how the settlement of Grantham has changed over the years and why people have settled here. We will be comparing Grantham to Ancaster, as a Roman town. We will be using grid references on a map and making our own maps.



Design and Technology: Electrical Systems

We will be learning about electrical items and how they work. We will be evaluating existing electrical items. We will then be designing, making and evaluating our own torches.



Music: Stack Attack!

We will understand the musical feature of Layering and how it is used to create music.



Computing: Data Logging

We will learn how and why data is collected over time. We will consider the senses that humans use to experience the environment and how computers can use special input devices called sensors to monitor the environment. We will collect data as well as access data captured over long periods of time. We will look at data points, data sets, and logging intervals.
